

Parish Council Meeting CVG Update for 20th May 2026.

Good evening, we have had a busy start to 2026 where many exciting changes have been happening. We have seen changes in the committee with new trustees joining at an exciting time - Welcome, Lucy Bohm & George Harty-Webb.

Lucy's key role within the team is to focus on fund raising using her extensive skills and experience in this area. George's brings a number of attributes particularly a skilled hands on approach to help in the up keep of the park but importantly also giving advice of what young families are looking for from the park as well as bringing new ideas for CVG.

We say a sad farewell and a big thank you to Tom Moore who stepped down from his chairmanship/trustee role in April and more recently (May) Lee Richardson as deputy chair, both having completed over 5 years at the park- we thank them both and wish them well.

We are also excited to share that Cavenham Green is now run as a registered charity and while the majority of the work has happened to move over the operations to the new charity, we are still working with Natural England and the Land Registry to finalise the transfer of the land from the original company to the charity. Once this is complete, we will also be moving the public liability insurance from the company to the charity and from that point onwards, we will close the company down and work solely under the banner of the charity Cavenham Green.

As a way of raising funds going forward we're thankful to Tom Moore for creating the Cavenham Farmers Market which he will run with the proceeds from pitch fees being donated to the charity to help build a more financially sustainable funding model for annual costs and those unexpected operational costs that pop up when looking after an asset like the Green alongside the donation we receive each year from the Parish Council Precept.
